APPEAL by Thomas Dockrell Son and Company Limited, of 41, South Great Georges Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 15th day of February, 1982 by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of an illuminated sign on the side of premises at the junction of Belgard Road and Colbert's Fort Road, Tallaght, County Dublin, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:


DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the retention of the said sign in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the condition specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said condition being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said condition.
