REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. These requirements must be fully ascertained and complied with before any construction work is put in hand. That the proposed diesel storage and service facilities be restricted to the company's own use and are not to be used for general public purposes or for sale to the public.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1984.
3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
