APPEAL by Leeson Advertising Limited of Parkmore Industrial Estate, Long Mile Road, Dublin, against the decision made on the 19th day of January, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin, deciding to refuse to grant permission for the retention of an advertising structure on a site at Newlands Cross, Naas Road, County Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said advertising structure for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The retention of the advertising structure endangers public safety by reason of traffic hazard as it tends to distract road users on the heavily-trafficked national primary route.

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned "to provide for the further development of agriculture" and to preserve open space amenity" in the Development Plan. The retention of this large obtrusive advertising structure would contravene materially the above objective, and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
2. The retention of this large obtrusive advertising boarding, immediately adjoining the Naas Dual Carriageway and in close proximity to the traffic lights at Newlands Cross would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard <sup>62-CAUS</sup> of the distraction to vehicle drivers on this heavily trafficked national primary route.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Floor 3, Blocks 6 & 7, Irish Life Centre, Lr. Abbey St., Dublin 1, and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
