In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ 4/107/82 dated .... 18/1/82 ..... decide to refuse:

For..... Proposed land infill development at Tymon South, Firhouse.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard, because of the generation of unacceptable turning movements of heavy vehicles onto the heavily trafficked Firhouse Road which already carries large traffic volumes.

2. The plans submitted do not provide any information with regard to:-

- (a) specification of works,
- (b) programme of works,
- (c) materials to be used,
- (d) duration of works.

The plans submitted do not provide detailed cross sections of the River Dodder in relation to existing levels and proposed finished levels together with adequate and satisfactory information regarding the feasibility of the works without interference with the existing river courses and flows.
