APPEAL by Bridget P. Devitt of Cluain Ard, New Road, Clondalkin, County Dublin, against the decision made on the 15th day of January, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin, deciding to refuse to grant permission for the retention of an advertising sign at Newlands Cross, Naas Road, County Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The retention of the advertising sign endangers public safety by reason of traffic hazard as it tends to distract road users on the heavily-trafficked national primary route.

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned generally "to provide for the further development of agriculture" and "to preserve open space amenity" in the Development Plan. The construction of this large obtrusive sign would contravene materially the above objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area, and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

2. The construction of this obtrusive and large sign, immediately adjoining the Naas Road Dual Carriageway National Primary Route N7, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because signs of this magnitude dwarf statutory road signs and compete for the attention of motorists with consequent distraction on this heavily trafficked fast National Primary Route.
