That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.</p>	<p>1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.</p> <p>2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.</p> <p>3. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development.
