

APPEAL by M. M. L. Holdings Limited of Naas Road, Dublin against the decision made on the 24th day of November, 1981, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the construction of an additional entrance to Industrial Unit Number 4, Ballymount Cross, Walkinstown, County Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, permission is hereby refused for the construction of the said entrance for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE
