REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. In respect the applicant to consult with the S&L Engineer regarding the treatment of the foundations because of the existence of a 600mm surface water drain passing under the proposed building. Applicant also to submit details of connection to main sewer to Sanitary Services Engineer.
6. That the external finish of the proposed building harmonise in texture and colour with the existing buildings.
7. That off-street car-parking be provided to Development Plan Standards for the existing and proposed development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of health.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazards.
5. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. In the interest of visual amenity.
7. In order to comply with the Development Plan standards.
