Dancing classes in the structure shall be limited to the following times:- Mondays and Thursdays from 3.30p.m. to 6.30p.m. and 7.30p.m. to 9.30 p.m. exclusive of Church, School or Public Holidays.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained. 2. To enable the effects of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining. 3. To minimise the effect of the development on the amenities of property in the vicinity.
