REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. That arrangements be made for the payment of financial contributions totalling £95,800 in respect of the overall development, prior to the commencement of development on this site.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to prior to the commencement of development.
5. That the necessary off-street car parking related to the scale and type of development proposed, be provided to the Development Plan standards and requirements.
6. That the structure be used solely for light industrial/warehouse and ancillary offices as set out in the application lodged 7.8.81 and any change of use be subject to the approval of the Planning Authority or An Bord Pleanála on appeal. Retail sales and supermarket activities are not permitted.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1984.
3. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
5. In order to comply with the requirements of the Development Plan.
5. To prevent unauthorised development.

7. That an adequate and comprehensive landscaping scheme and boundary treatment, including walls, railings, fencing, with particular regard to the Belgard Road frontage, be submitted to and approved by the County Council before any construction work is commenced.

8. That access to the site for any purpose is not permitted by way of Colbert's Fort Road.

9. That sole access to the site is to be at the main access, flanking of blocks 1 and 12 & immediately opposite the junction of Alston Road with Belgard Road.

10. That the requirements of the Roads Engineering be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

11. That construction works should not commence until such time as the internal roads network is completed to the appropriate standard.

7. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

8. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of traffic hazard.

9. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area and in the interest of public safety and avoidance of traffic hazard.
