1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application. 2. That the applicant indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public public structure. 3. That the applicant make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure. 4. That the applicant accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense if such is necessary, for the the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and removal of any services installed in the public street. 5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights. 6. Proposed bus shelter to be relocated minimum of 3' from the carriageway kerb. 7. That the applicant ascertain and comply with the requirements of the Council's Parks Department before development is commenced.	1.
