A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

proposed laying of 130 yds. of 8" and 9" sewer at Boat Road, Clonsilla.

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained, and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. That the sewer be laid in a 150mm diameter pipe throughout its length.
4. That the applicant consult with Sanitary Services and agree a financial contribution to be made in relation to remedial works to be carried out downstream of the Green Isle Hotel. This contribution to be made prior to commencement of development.
5. That minimum cover be provided both when crossing the road and under the footpath. Details to be agreed with Sanitary Services.
6. That the applicant consult with Roads Traffic Dept. regarding traffic safety during the laying of the sewer.
7. That the proposed sewer be relocated by the applicants at their own expense in the event of road widening.
8. That details of the construction operations be agreed with the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
