1. The retention of the existing signs which are located in close proximity to two sets of traffic lights would distract road users thereby endangering public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
2. The proposed development would contravene materially a condition which is attached to two previous permissions i.e. condition no. 7 of Order No. PA/1169/81, dated 5.6.81, Reg. Ref. WA 623, and Order No. PA/1819/81, 7.8.81 Reg. Ref. WA 1152, and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
