6. That no development take place within 4.5m. of the acquisition line of the proposed road. Details regarding set back of pumps and canopy to be agreed with Roads Engineer prior to commencement of development.
7. Details of landscaping and boundary treatment to be the subject of agreement with the Planning Authority.
