REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. That car parking to Development Plan Standards be provided on the site for existing and proposed development.
7. That the structure shall be removed on or before 1st August, 1985, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In the interest of health.
5. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Services Department.
6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
7. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
