3. That before development commences the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. That the requirements of the Roads Department be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
7. That a suitable boundary treatment landscaping scheme and programme for such works be submitted to and approved by the County Council.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

3. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

That a financial contribution in the sum of £3,125. be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

10. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of
