3. That the external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing structure.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the satisfactory design and location of the proposed septic tank drainage system be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. These matters must be the subject of consultation and agreement with the Health Inspectors Department, Eastern Health Board, 33 Gardiner Place, Dublin 1 before any constructional work commences.
