APPEAL by Richard McGlew of 110, Silverlawn, Navan, County Meath, against the decision made on the 26th day of June, 1981, by the Council of the County of Dublin, deciding to refuse outline permission for the erection of a house at Boherboy, Saggart, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, outline permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said house for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

- 1. It is an objective of the planning authority, as set out in the Dublin County Development Plan, to reserve the area in which the site is located for the further development of agriculture. This objective is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and would militate against the preservation of the rural environment.
- 2. The site fronts onto a heavily trafficked and substandard road

  and the creation of a further access point at this location would give rise to traffic hazard and interfere with the safety and free flow of traffic on the road due to the additional traffic-turning movements which would be generated by the proposed development.
