REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. That details relating to layout, siting, height, design and external appearance of the proposed building and means of access thereto shall be submitted to and approved by the Planning Authority before any works are begun.
1. That no development be undertaken until detailed plans have been submitted to and approved by the Council under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963.
2. That the proposed water supply and drainage arrangements and particularly the design and location of the proposed water wells and septic tank tanks, especially in regard to the possible contamination of the streams traversing the sites shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
3. That any necessary land required for road improvement purposes be reserved as such and kept free from building development.
4. That a financial contribution to be determined by the Planning Authority on submission of detailed plans for approval be paid by the applicant to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development of the site.

1. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
1. In order to comply with the requirement of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the Developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
