# AN BORD PLEANALA

APPEAL by James Conlon of 6, St. Maeldruans Terrace, Tallaght, County Dublin against the decision made on the 11th day of June, 1981, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse a permission for the retention of a shop, tyre bay and yard at 6, St. Maeldruans Terrace, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the said retention for the reasons set out in the schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

- 1. The site is located in a predominantly residential area and the proposed retention would be injurious to the residential amenities of property in the vicinity by reason of appearance and its commercial nature and would thereby depreciate the value of such property.
- 2. The additional traffic turning movements which would be generated by the development on a heavily-trafficked road and the on-street parking close to a complex junction which would seriously restrict visibility, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
- 3. The development would lead to on-street car-parking in the vicinity of St. Damien's Road/Oldbawn Road junction and this would seriously impair sight lines at this junction thereby endangering public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
