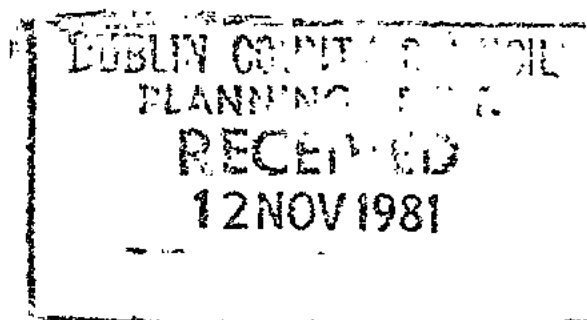

A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed refuse transfer station at Greenview, Greenhills Road, Sandymount

## CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the refuse transfer station cease to operate on or before 30th September, 1983, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the County Council.
5. That the proposed new entrance and access arrangements including revisions to boundaries providing for adequate and safe traffic vision splays are to be constructed immediately to the requirements of the Council's Roads Department before any further use of these lands is permitted.
6. That a financial contribution in the sum of £7,000. be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of County Council special road widening works on the site frontage which will facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

## REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
6. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development, it is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

With reference to your planning application received here on 9th April, 1981, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976 the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Further information is required which should provide for:-
  - a. Clarification of nature of materials to be handled on the site, with specific confirmation that toxic materials would not be involved.
  - b. Details of applicants proposals to deal with any leachate resulting from compaction operations on site.
  - c. Specific details of proposed fire protection arrangements, particularly with regard to sprinkler systems.
  - d. Clarification of applicant's proposals with regard to dust extraction arrangements.
  - e. Clarification of proposed sound installations, together with details of internal layout of the structure.
  - f. Clarification of written consent for way leaves for outfall pipe systems over lands not in the applicant's ownership and control.
  - g. Specific details of the proposed vehicular movements to and from the site including the type of vehicle and specific proposals for ensuring that materials transferred are covered so as to avoid accidental spillage on public roads.
