The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and the grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanála, Block 6 & 7, Irish Life Centre, Lr. Abbey Street, Dublin 1 and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanála will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
