With reference to your planning application received here on 4th March, 1981, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. In view of the fact that the extension provides for a total of six windows on the common boundary overlooking adjoining properties the applicant should indicate if he has the written agreement of the adjoining property owners for the windows, as proposed, if so evidence of such agreements should be submitted.
2. The applicant should indicate if he is prepared to pay a financial contribution to the County Council in lieu of carparking provision.
