1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application. 2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development. 3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. 4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. In this respect a lobby which is separately and permanently ventilated to the outer air must be provided between the surgery and w.c. 5. That before development commences the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. 6. That this permission shall cease to have effect after two years from the date of this Notice unless prior to that time permission for its retention shall have been obtained from the Planning Authority or on appeal by An Bord Pleanála.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained. 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1934. 3. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. 4. In the interest of health. 5. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard. 6. To enable the effects of the development on the amenity of the area to be reviewed having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
