With reference to your planning application received hereon 26th November, 1980, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The site of the proposed development slopes steeply from the cul-de-sac where access is proposed. It would appear to be very difficult to provide a drive-way with an acceptable slope. The applicant should submit a contour survey of the site and a long section of the proposed drive-way. The applicant is advised to consult with the Roads Engineer in this matter.
