<u>DECISION:</u> Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the said housing development for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

- There are no public sewerage facilities available to serve the proposed development and the said development would, therefore, be premature by reason of such deficiency and the period within which it may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- 2. Frontage development onto the narrow substandard Lucan/Newcastle Road would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and the sites are too narrow and the topography unsuitable to enable any measures to be taken to overcome this difficulty.
- 3. The Lucan/Clondalkin Road is substandard particularly along that section where the new access is proposed and the traffic generated by the proposed development would, therefore, endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
