5. That the necessary footpaths and lay-by arrangements be provided along school frontage onto the proposed access roads and must be available before the school is operational.
6. That an adequate and satisfactory landscaping be submitted to and approved by the County Council.
7. That additional off street car parking and adequate circulation be provided in the event that the school is extended at a later stage.
