1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application. 2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development. 3. That the requirements of the Sanitary Services Department be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. 4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. 5. That car parking facilities be provided in accordance with the standards set out in the County Development Plan. 6. That a financial contribution in the sum of £382.00 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained. 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964. 3. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. 4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard. 5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area. 6. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
