**Proposed two-number, pre-fabricated buildings, at rear of Scoll Chronain, Main Street,
Rathgar, Co. Dublin.**

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Sanitary Services Department be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That a satisfactory landscaping scheme and programme for such be submitted to and approved by the County Council.
6. That the structure shall be removed on or before 30/9/82, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on Appeal.
7. That the proposed 9-in. block wall, 8-ft. in height, at the west side, be structurally stable and constructed in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
