For **proposed refuse transfer station at Greenview, Greenhills Road, Dublin 12.**

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would result in significant additional movements by heavy vehicles on the inadequate road system in the vicinity and such vehicle movements would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and tend to create serious traffic congestion.
2. The proposed development is premature pending the completed construction of the Council's major road network in the area.

Abbey Street, Dublin 1 and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanála will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
