A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the proposed underground tank be relocated on site so as not to lie under the reservation for the Whitechurch Road Improvement. The exact line of this reservation is to be set out on site and checked by an engineer from the Roads Department before development commences.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1978-1984.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
