3. That the proposed structure be removed on or before the 31st August, 1985 unless before that time approval has been obtained for its retention from the Planning Authority or from An Bord Pleanála, on appeal.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Office be ascertained and strictly adhered to in this development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangement be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

2. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878/1984.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
