### REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. Prior to commencement of development that the sum of £100. be paid by the applicant to Dublin County Council towards the cost of the provision and development of open space in the area and which facilitates the development.
3. That a 6-ft. high boundary wall, in blockwork or similar durable materials, rendered and capped to the satisfaction of the County Council, be constructed at the southern and eastern boundaries of the site.
4. That the area now proposed for inclusion within the curtilage of No. 17 Ard Macha, be maintained as private open space associated with garden use to No. 17.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. The provision of such services in the area will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the applicant should contribute towards the cost of provision of open space.
3. In the interest of amenity.
4. In the interest of the proper planning and development and in the interests of residential amenity.
