DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Because of its proximity to two important road junctions on a national primary road, the retention of the sign endangers public safety by reason of traffic hazard and is also injurious to the visual amenities of the area.
