for the following reasons:

1. An illuminated sign of the magnitude proposed would compete for the attention of motorists and dwarf statutory road signs on the heavily trafficked Greenhills Road thereby endangering public safety by reason of traffic hazard.

2. The proposed sign would destroy the pristine nature of the gable end of this structure and be seriously injurious to the visual amenity of the area.
