CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the Plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the run-off from any spillage areas should be subject to the provisions of the Water Pollution, Act, 1977. The applicant must insure that no spillage run-off is permitted into the main drainage system.
5. That the proposed storage tank and pump be restricted to the use of the existing premises and not for use by the Public at large.

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1872-1964.
3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1872-1964 and in order to comply with the Water Pollution Act, 1977.
5. To prevent unauthorised development.
