With reference to your planning application received here on 7th March, 1980, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976 the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Further information should be submitted which should provide for:-
 - a. Specific details of the proposed industrial uses or processes together with the number of persons to be employed and the anticipated water consumption.
 - b. Details of any effluent discharge together with the anticipated quantity expected from any manufacturing process.
 - c. An indication of the expected commercial vehicular movements to and from the site together with the type of vehicle envisaged.
 - d. An adjusted ~~alternative~~ off street car parking arrangement which shall provide for the required off street car parking location clear of the road improvement line boundary.
