A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

**Proposed retention of Cricket Pavilion at The Hill, Skerries, Co. Dublin.**

### CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the requirements of the Sanitary Services Department and Supervising Health Inspector regarding drainage be ascertained within three months of the date of grant of permission and strictly adhered to.
3. That an indigenous hedge, such as hawthorn, be planted inside the chainlink fence on the south boundary to screen the building from the public road; this hedge to be planted within three months of the date of receipt of planning permission.
4. That a financial contribution in the sum of £130.00 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid forthwith.

### REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
3. In the interest of visual amenity.
4. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
