With reference to your planning application received here on 15th February, 1980, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Applicant to submit full details of the water supply layout to serve the proposed development.
2. Applicant to submit written permission from the owner of the foul and surface water mains indicated to connect thereto and also evidence of his right to cross land to connect to these pipes.
3. Applicant to submit details of hammerhead turning area after consultation with the Roads Department of Dublin County Council. The applicant must also submit details of the necessary frontage works required for the purpose of providing adequate and satisfactory access to the hammerhead and footpath facilities between the hammerhead and house No. 1 of Phase 1 of the development.
