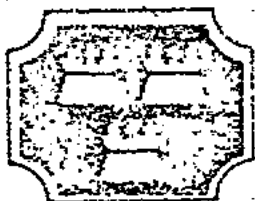


Dear Sir,

I am directed by the Assistant City and County Manager to advise you that the planning authority sees no objection to the above proposal subject to compliance with the following requirements of the Roads Section of the Engineering Department:-

- (a) All surface water from new work to be trapped and discharged to drains within the boundary of the site, such discharge to be made to the surface water drains where the drainage is on the separate system.
- (b) All manholes, P.D.'s, F.A.I.'s etc to be located within the boundary of the site.
- (c) Gates must not open outwards over public footpath.

I am also to inform you that if it is considered essential that off street car parking be provided in connection with any proposed permanent court house accommodation.
