REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences, Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of that approval shall be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
5. That the area in front of the buildings between them and the adjoining estate road boundaries shall not be used for the storage of plant, materials or machinery.
6. That the proposed structure be used for ancillary office purposes, as set out in the application, dated 23/12/79, and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of the Planning Authority, or An Bord Pleanála, on appeal.
