In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ A/199/80 dated 1/2/80 decide to refuse:

For... Proposed use of land for parking of motor vehicles and farming and other mechanical equipment, at Brownsbarn Townland. for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the generation of additional commercial and industrial traffic turning movements to and from the site on to the heavily trafficked Naas Road dual-carriageway Primary Route (N,7).
2. The site proposed for development is located in an area zoned "to provide for the further development of agriculture" in the Development Plan. The commercial and industrial use proposed would contravene materially this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity.
