That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. 6. That a financial contribution in the sum of £155.00 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained. 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964. 3.
