A Chara,

With reference to your planning application received here on 8th February, 1979, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. (a) The applicant's specific proposals for the existing house on this site. The applicant is advised that the demolition, or change of use, of the existing house, will require the Council's consent under the Housing Act of 1969, and the application should initially be made to the Council for that purpose.
- (b) Specific evidence of the suitability of the site for septic tank drainage, together with specific evidence that an adequate and potable water supply to serve the proposed development can be provided.
- (c) Specific details of adequate and safe access to the existing public road which should provide for adequate vision splays to the requirements of the Roads Department.

Note: The applicant must consult with the County Council with regard to these matters before submitting any further information.

The applicant should mark his reply 'Additional Information' and quote the Register Reference Number given above.
