A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed alterations to elevations of health centre and day nursery at Roulagh
Neighbourhood Centre, Clonsilla, Co. Dublin.

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences, Building Bye-Laws approval be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Services Engineers.
6. That nine off-street car parking spaces be provided on the applicants' site as indicated on plan 471.16A.
7. That the applicant construct footpaths a minimum of 10-ft. wide to the north and south of the Health Centre and nursery, as detailed on CP.8546, to County Council standards; details to be agreed with Planning Authority.
8. That the applicant negotiate access to the site with Dublin Corporation; such arrangements are to be agreed with the Planning Authority before development commences.
