With reference to your planning application received here on 10th October, 1979 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976 the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate :-

1. As it is not possible to determine the true position of proposed houses to adjoining estate roads applicant should submit plans to an adequate scale (1:500) showing layout of the proposed development, fully dimensioned with regard to site curtilages, houses locations, building lines, rear gardens clearances and specific relationship of the sites and adjoining estate road proposals to the Southern Cross Route Motorway reservation of the south boundary of the site. The correct location of the motorway reservation, together with the correct estate road locations, are to be clearly shown on the 1:500 scale detailed layout.
