1. The County Council of the County of Dublin have made a Scheme pursuant to Section 4 of the Local Government (Roads and Motorways) Act, 1974 which is about to be submitted to the Minister for the Environment for approval. A copy of the Scheme and the relevant map may be seen at 2/3 Parnell Square, Dublin 1 between the hours of 9.30 am. to 12.30 pm. and 2.00 pm. to 4.30 pm. on the normal working days of the road authority.
2. As the lands which are the subject of the above mentioned grant of planning permission are affected by the Scheme, i.e. Plot No. 19.b as indicated on Drawing No. SLA. 246/85. And as the permitted development has not commenced/is not completed, you are hereby notified that the grant of planning permission is hereby modified to the following extent:-  
By the addition of three further conditions as follows:-
  12. That the site layout be modified as per Drawing D.P. 9994 to take account of the lands required for the western parkway reservation.  
REASON: To facilitate the construction of the proposed western parkway.
  13. That the lands required for the western parkway be reserved as such and be retained free from development.  
REASON: To facilitate construction of the proposed western parkway.
  14. No access shall be permitted onto lands required for the motorway scheme.  
REASON: To facilitate the construction of the Proposed Motorway.
3. The Minister may not approve the Scheme until he has caused a public local enquiry to be held into all matters relating to it and has considered the report of the enquiry and any objections made to the Scheme which have not been withdrawn.
4. Written objections to the Scheme may be lodged with the Minister for the Environment and should be addressed to the Minister for the Environment at the Custom House, Dublin 1, so as to reach him before the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 1985.

That the necessary roadworks be constructed by the applicants as shown on the plans submitted and referred to in the architect's letter, dated 18th October, 1977 between Ballymount <sup>2073</sup> Cross and the Western Boundary of the site and be to the constructional standards and specification, including public lighting and drainage, of the Roads Department. The applicants must agree the programme and all Council requirements with the Roads Department.
