

With reference to your planning application received here on 7th September, 1979, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976 the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Discharge of effluent from the treatment plant to the River Liffey is not acceptable. An alternative proposal should be considered. If land drainage is envisaged percolation tests and water table tests must be carried out to indicate soil suitability. In this regard the applicant to consult with the Sanitary Services Department prior to submission of the additional information.

2. Performance information, if any, on this type of treatment plant should be submitted.

3. The boundary of the site should be indicated.

N.B. The applicant should mark his reply "Additional Information" and quote the Register Reference Number given above.
