- (b) Specific evidence of soil suitability for the disposal of septic tank effluent. The applicant must consult with the Health Inspector's Department, Eastern Health Board, with regard to these matters.
- (c) An indication of the type of light industrial uses proposed, together with the scope of activities envisaged.
- (d) An indication of any proposed structures on the lands.
