### REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission that the development be strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. A Certificate of structural soundness from a competent structural engineer to be submitted by the applicant to the Planning Authority.
3. The Planning Authority's requirements with regard to any excavations or re-installments works in carriageways, verges and footpaths to be strictly adhered to.
4. The applicant provide any lighting conductor required and aerial navigation lights required by the Department of Transport and Power and check with them to ascertain if this is necessary.
5. Permission for this development is limited to seven years from the date of grant of Planning Permission. The communal television aerial to be removed by the owner at his own expense, at the expiring of that period unless the Planning Authority issue a further permission, on application being made to them for the retention of the aerial beyond that date.
6. The aerial to be self-supporting and not to require tie wires.
7. Prior to commencement of development the proposer to submit to the Planning Department for approval particulars of all necessary measures to be taken to
